- 5. All work must be accompanied by a completed entry form. Submissions are to be made to the Dalhousie Art Gallery between 1-27 November, during regular Gallery hours: Tuesday to Friday, 11 am to 5 pm; weekends noon to 5 pm. Please note that the Gallery is closed on Mondays.
- 6. You and your friends are invited to the opening reception on Thursday 8 December, 4-6 pm.
- 7. The Gallery cannot accept responsibility for any damage or loss. Every possible precaution will be taken to secure works but there will be no insurance coverage for this exhibition. Jewellry and small objects will be exhibited in secure cases.
